USD #374 Part-Time Student Policy

HB 2567 ~ Part-Time Enrollment

The bill requires school districts to allow for the part-time enrollment of students who are also enrolled in a private or homeschool. Each board of education of a school district must adopt a policy to allow such students to enroll and attend any courses, programs, or services offered by the school district.

If school districts receive specific scheduling requests from part-time enrolled students, the bill requires the school district to make a good-faith attempt to accommodate such requests, but the bill would not require such school districts to accommodate all requests.

Part-Time Student Policy/Requirements

- 1. Part-time students will be required to meet and are subject to all USD #374 student policies. These include, but are not limited to, district attendance policies, district dress code policies, and student behavior/discipline policies.
- 2. Part-time students are required to attend school/classes regularly. State truancy policies will be enforced.
- 3. Classes will be on campus only.
- 4. Part-time students must be enrolled in at least five classes in order to participate in all school activities that are not KSHSAA sanctioned. These <u>may include but are not limited to</u>; prom, school dances, being eligible for king and queen nominations, holding class offices, participating in school voting, school clubs and/or organizations, senior recognition nights, etc.
- 6. If the class the student is enrolled in requires activities outside of the school day and is part of their grade (concerts, meetings, etc.), students will be required to attend such activities.
- 8. Participation fees will not be prorated. Part-time students will pay the same fees as full-time students.
- 9. All part-time student requirements may be waived at any time and is at the discretion of the administration.
