Item #1 Call Meeting to Order /Approve Agenda

The President called the meeting to order at 4:05 p.m. Mr. Dyck moved, seconded by Mr. Froese to approve the agenda. The motion carried 5-0.

Item #2 Approve Minutes

Mr. Webber moved, seconded by Mr. Dyck, to approve the minutes of the April 10, 2023 Special Meeting and Regular Meeting. The motion carried 5-0.

Item #3 Treasurer's Report

Prior to the meeting, Mr. Dyck, Mr. Pena, Mr. Webber and Mrs. Wiswell reviewed Purchase Orders and supporting documents presented for payment. \$59,877.38 from General to At Risk; \$1,654.68 from General Fund to 4-Year Old At Risk, \$4,864.65 from General to Daycare; \$17.301.36 from General to Bilingual; \$16,813.68 from General to Food Service; \$2,512.89 from General to Vocational Fund, \$636.15 from General Fund to Small Rural Schools. Mr. Webber moved, seconded by Mrs. Wiswell, to approve the bills as listed on the List of Warrants dated 04/30/23 and authorize payment and transfers. The motion carried 5-0.

Item #4 Communications

The Board received a Thank You note from Ms. Phoenix for the Public School Foundations donation to allow for the purchase of Ozobots for her classroom.

Reports

Curriculum

Mrs. Pena submitted a written report. She reported all P.O.s from teachers for next year's purchases have been completed. Work will be done on a tiered intervention plan for behavior for next year. She is planning an Amazing Race game for staff Wednesday evening as a fun ending to the year.

Principals

Mr. Murphy submitted a written report. He reported Prom was well attended. FFA had their district and chapter banquets. They hosted Day at the Farm in conjunction with Satanta FFA for the elementary students. They also competed at a state event in Manhattan. HS choir attended the large group music festival in Dodge City and the Band and Choir traveled to state solo and ensemble in Salina where they did very well! Prom was well attended and went well. All classified evaluations have been completed and turned into Mr. Richardson. Seniors participated in signing day and had a lot of fun doing that. There was a career fair for all students.

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Several businesses from the community were brought in to showcase their business for our students. Baccalaureate was well attended. Everything is ready to go for HS Graduation and MS Promotion.

Mrs. Lee submitted a written report. 30 students were enrolled in Pre-K. The Fifth Grade had their D.A.R.E. presentation during Friday morning meeting. The instruction is geared toward decision-making and utilizing the D.A.R.E. model. Content covered included Safe and responsible choices, risky situations, responding to pressure, signs of stress, evaluating your decision, confident communication, and bullying. The After School program will wrap up on Thursday, May 10. Kindergarten graduation was May 17, and Sixth Grade promotion on the 18th. Retirement celebrations for Mike Lower, Shelly Wagner and Debbie Weeks were Thursday, May 18. She thanked the Board of Education for their continued support and guidance.

Mrs. Murphy submitted a written report. District testing is finished. KELPA scores for ESL students are back and state assessment scores have been released. Reports will be sent out to parents. Feedback on Sr. signing day had good feedback and 27 of 29 students participated. The seven applications for the CTE pathways were submitted and approved. Character Strong curriculum will continue to be used for the MS students. The HS students will utilize EverFi and Jostens to provide the curriculum needed to meet the SEL standards.

Mr. Webber moved, seconded by Mrs. Wiswell to the Hiring of Kasey Wellmann, HS Science; Tregg Rodriguez, MS/HS Physical Education; and Melissa Berg, HS English/ FACS. The motion carried 4-0.
